What is the PIT Count?

The Point-in Time (PIT) Count is a one-day estimate of homeless populations in our community that captures the number and characteristics of people who are experiencing homelessness.

Why?

Knowing the number and nature of people who are homeless and understanding the trends can help communities better understand the scope of the problem, improve system efficiency, strategically target scarce resources and promote effective interventions in Stanislaus County.

How can you help?

Homeless Count Surveyor (Unsheltered Count)

Volunteers are needed to canvas our local communities, hand out comfort kits and conduct surveys with our neighbors experiencing homelessness. This count takes place county-wide and volunteers are needed at multiple locations. (Volunteers *must be 18 years of age or older*, mandatory training required.
