**Current Status:**

**1. As of Tuesday, March 31st, 2020, Stanislaus County has 39 confirmed positive cases of COVID-19, 0 deaths, and 1171 Negative tests.** Statistics for neighboring Counties are as follows (per their respective websites):

- Alameda County: 294 Confirmed Cases, 7 Death (3/31/2020)
- Calaveras County: 3 Confirmed Cases, 0 Deaths (3/30/2020)
- San Joaquin County: 141 Confirmed Cases, 7 Deaths (3/31/2020)
- Mariposa County: 0 Confirmed Cases, 0 Deaths (3/30/2020)
- Merced County: 10 Confirmed Case, 0 Deaths (3/30/2020)
- Santa Clara County: 890 Confirmed Cases, 30 Deaths (3/30/2020)
- Tuolumne County: 1 Confirmed Cases, 0 Deaths (3/30/2020)

In California, as of March 30th, 2020, there are 7,138 confirmed cases and 105 deaths (Johns Hopkins).
