

2022 PIT Volunteer FAQs

When and where will the unsheltered count occur?

The unsheltered count will occur on Thursday, February 24th, 2022, beginning 6-7:00 am to noon. You will be assigned a location based on your selection from the volunteer registration portal.

Where can I register to volunteer?

Individuals can register and complete the volunteer registration portal at <http://stanislaus.pointintime.info/>

Can we sign up as a group?

Each team member will need to register separately and enter a "Team Name" in the volunteer registration portal (this will help us to ensure you are placed on the same group).

How many training sessions should I select?

You are required to attend one virtual training session (please remember to mark your calendars). A Microsoft Teams invite will be sent to your email in January.

Will I need a mobile phone on the day of the unsheltered count?

Yes, you will need a mobile phone to complete the electronic unsheltered surveys from the Counting Us App.

When is the last day I can register to be a volunteer?

The volunteer registration portal will close on Friday, February 4th, 2022.

I made a mistake in my registration, how can I fix it?

Do I need to attend the mandatory training even if I volunteered for past PIT Counts?

Yes. This is required for safety reasons. Also, a new software mobile phone app will be used for this upcoming count. Lastly, it is important to review how to properly how to conduct survey questions as HUD guidelines may slightly change year to year.

How old must I be to participate in the PIT Count?

You must be 18 years of age by the time of the count to participate.
